openx package opener

girlawhirl finds the OpenX package opener makes quick work of plastic packages

Mini-electric toothbrushes encased in sheets of impenetrable plastic and CDs and DVDs that are ridiculously difficult to open because of their clamshell-like wrapping. Why does everything she buys have to come in these packages? It's gotten to the point where she has a specific pair of scissors, once ruined by the process, that she has saved to use on all those difficult to open items...

But a Super Pal just turned her on to a little gizmo that slides right through those tough layers of plastic. It's called *OpenX* by **Ranchmark, Inc.**, It's a nifty handheld tool equipped with sharp blades that effortlessly slice right through the formerly impervious plastic. In just two steps and a flick of her wrist, Girlawhirl is able to pierce the packaging surrounding her new headphones and safely extract them without any cuts, bruises, or damage to the product.

The *OpenX* is also ideal for boxes and shipment envelopes because it lets Girlawhirl make a neat slice right through the packaging tape, instead of her usual effective yet messy struggle-with-the-box-until-it-bursts-open-and-styrofoam-peanuts-fly-everywhere method. The *OpenX* also makes releasing a CD or DVD from its case less a 15 minute struggle and more a five second procedure.
